The Los Angeles military commandant wins momentary victory by thwarting a revolt of hidalgos and landowners in the action filled "Monastario Sets a Trap" episode of Walt Disney's "Zorro" series to be aired over station \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ p.m.

Angered at harsh treatment suffered by the captive Dona Luisa (MADELEINE HOLMES) and her daughter Elena Tores (EUGENIA PAUL), Don Alejandro (GEORGE LEWIS) rouses his friends in an attempt to seize control of the military government, and free the prisoners. Don Alejandro's son, Diego (GUY WILLIAMS) cautions against the plan, but his advice is ignored.

Realizing the dons are riding into a trap prepared by Capitan Monastario (BRITT LOMOND), Diego casts aside his nobleman's attire for that of the feared raider, Zorro.

The masked avenger tries to decoy the soldiers from the fort. Monastario, however, sees through the plan and sends only a few lancers to pursue him. In the ensuing action, Alejandro and his friends are ambushed, and the wealthy hidalgo is wounded in the retreat. Zorro manages to ride his injured father to the temporary security of the hills with a secret vow to seek vengeance.

"Monastario Sets a Trap" was directed by Lewis R. Foster. The teleplay by Lowell S. Hawley was based on Joel Kane's story. Also appearing in this episode are Henry Calvin as Sergeant Garcia, Gene Sheldon as Bernardo, and Than Wyenn as Licenciado Pina.
